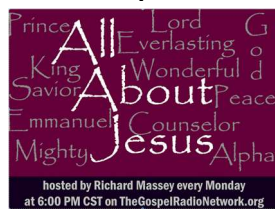

The Family of God

"These things I write to you, though I hope to come to you shortly; but if I am delayed, I write so that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth." 1 Tim. 3:14-15

Metaphorically speaking the Bible compares the church to various things such as the body of Christ, the kingdom of God, the temple of the Lord, the vineyard of the Lord, and as seen in our text, the "**house of God**". Scripture makes it clear that God is the Father of His household (Matt. 23:9) and Christ is Son over that house (Heb. 3:6).

So where do we fit in? Well, according to the Bible, Christians are also members of God's household (Eph. 2:19). In other words, we are part of the family of God! When we were baptized into Christ we became "**sons of God**" (Gal. 3:26-27). It was Jesus who first indicated that His family actually consisted of those who are obedient to the will of His Father in heaven (Matt. 12:46-50), and the Hebrew writer confirmed that as Christians we are indeed Christ's brethren (Heb. 2:10-12).

But do you really think of yourself as a member of the family of God? If so, how much attention do you give to the relationships associated with this spiritual family unit? There is much more involved you see, than just calling God our Father and each other brother and sister.

What holds a physical family unit together? Is it not love for one another? Is not that the formula God ordered for His spiritual family as well (1 John 4:7-11)? In any family situation, physical or spiritual, there will be times of frustrations, frictions, pains, and problems, but there will also be times of great joy. As we labor collectively we can expect to experience some of both.

However, biblical fellowship and peace is possible if we understand and appreciate that we are to be an active part in God's family, willing to obey Him and work for the good of each other. Think on these things.
