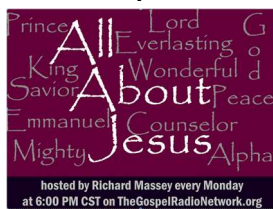

Do You Understand What Being A Christian Involves?

"Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desire to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me."

Matthew 16:24

Many people show little understanding of what is involved in living the Christian life. This approach actually begins with some before their conversion. They wonder just how little must I do in order to become saved. Later they reason, how little can I do and remain saved. Jesus never promised that being a Christian would be easy—He just taught that it would be worth it.

Those who really want to be saved will take their salvation seriously and take the initiative to:

- ✓ Believe and completely obey Christ as their Savior (**Mark 16:16; cf. Heb. 5:9**).
- ✓ Forgive others as they themselves have been forgiven (**Matt. 6:14-15; Eph 4:32**)
- ✓ Be a positive example and influence to others (**Matt. 5:16; cf. 1 Pet. 2:21**).
- ✓ Take the yoke of Christ upon themselves (**Matt. 11:28-30; cf. 1 John 5:3**).
- ✓ Become a servant of righteousness (**Rom. 6: 17-18; cf. Josh. 24: 15**).
- ✓ Put the Lord, and His kingdom first (**Matt. 6:33; 2 Tim. 4: 10**).
- ✓ Present their body as a living sacrifice (**Rom. 12:1-2; 1 Pet. 1:14-15**).
- ✓ Be willing to suffer for Christ (**James 1:2-6; 1 Pet. 4:16**).
- ✓ Take the Gospel to others (**Matt. 28:19-20; Rom. 1:15-16**).
- ✓ Be Faithful unto death (**1 Cor. 15: 58; Rev. 2:10**).

Sadly some claim to be a Christian while at the same time living a worldly life. But saying something doesn't necessarily make it so. One who is not a true Christian is existing—but not really living (John 10:10). So remember, the most important thing in this life is not living for today, but preparing for death and eternity by committing to the Lord.

Are your sins forgiven you? Do you have a home in heaven awaiting? Think on these things.
