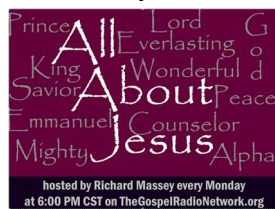

Alive or Dead?

The church of Christ at Sardis was said to have "...**a name that thou livest, and art dead**" (Rev. 3:1). It has been correctly called "the church of the living dead." It was alive physically, but, was dead spiritually; and that's an awful state. That cannot be the way to please God. We need to be a church that is alive; but how can we know we are alive. Consider the following and let's be sure we do those things that will keep us spiritually alive.

1. An alive church is a **hungry church**. Jesus said blessings upon the hungry, "**Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled**" (Matt. 5:8). The very first church did this when they continued steadfastly in the apostle's doctrine (teaching) (Acts 2:42). Will you attend all Bible classes and worship assemblies as we open the word of God together?
2. An alive church is an **evangelistic church**. The church exists as a soul saving station in a world of people drowning in sin. We must throw out the life line as one of our hymns states and try to save the lost and dying (Mark 16:15-16; Acts 5:41-42; 8:4). Will you help keep the church alive and well by doing what you can to invite the lost or hand out tracts?
3. An alive church is a **teaching church**. Hebrews 5:12 says, "**For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.**" We love our teachers, but we can certainly use more. Can you consider doing some teaching? You can sit in classes and learn how its done, and be brought along slowly. Faith must be in action...James 2:26.
4. An alive church **shows its love**. 1 John 3:18 says that we must love by our actions. Fellowship together, worship together, pray for one another, text or call each other, be forgiving of the other and longsuffering; put the needs of others first (Phil. 2:1-5).

Perhaps there are other characteristics of a living, dynamic congregation that you can also name. Feel free to add to the list, and may the Lord help us to grown spiritually and numerically as we serve Him. Let's avoid being like the church in Sardis. Just be active in all of the above areas and watch how this congregation will flourish.
