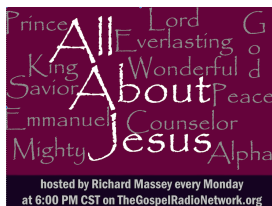

Jesus Love Me This I Know...

It often seems the most basic of Bible truths are the most impactful. Obviously many in the world today are fearful, unsure, intimidated and confused. If we could simply teach every person on the Earth that Jesus loves them, and what that truly means.

The words of the song most of us learned as children are not only true they are life changing.

Jesus loves me this I know; for the Bible tells me so

Each of us is a special individual made in the image of God (Gen.1:26).

Each one of us matter a great deal to God, so much so that He sent His only begotten Son to die in order to offer salvation to us all (Jn. 3:16). I can only know this by reading and pondering the great truths of the Bible (Rom. 10:17). Most people are resistant to the idea of actually studying the Bible. No doubt they have heard many falsehoods about God, the Bible, Christians, etc., and they are leery.

Since they fail to read the Bible they cannot ever have an appreciation for Jesus. Nor can they learn about their personal sins and His personal sacrifice to save them. They will continue to come to ill informed (wrong) conclusions (Pro. 14:12). They languish in darkness and despair; when what they need (and truly have always wanted) is offered by the loving Lord (James 1: 17).

Most people are seeking security. Money, power and acceptance seem to offer this—but such is a mirage. They are finding comfort in an illusion. The primary theme of the Book of Ecclesiastes is an attempt to determine the meaning of life: Which the Holy Spirit does give Solomon. Note the Divine conclusion, ***“Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.”*** A man who lives his life without God is “less of a man” than he should be. We can never have “without” God what we have “with” God.

I love the encouraging words of the great prophet Isaiah, ***“Fear not for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee, yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.”***

Little ones to Him belong, they are weak but He is strong The Psalmist once raised the question, “Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?” Life without God is bleak. Upon reflection a life lived without God is empty and this fact often leads the godless on the earth to be filled with rage. While this is probably a “normal” reaction; It is not a profitable one.
